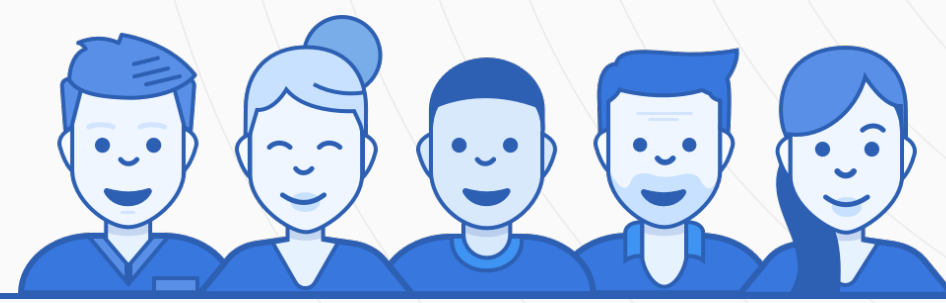

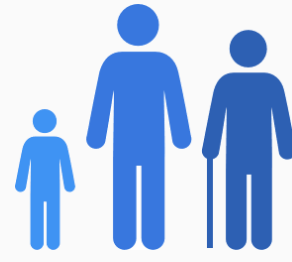


Crime rate

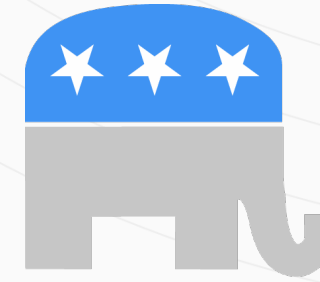
