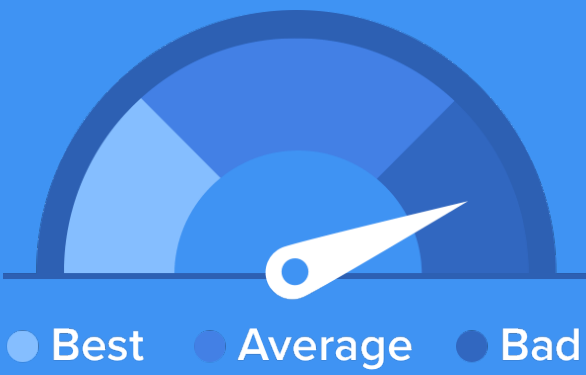

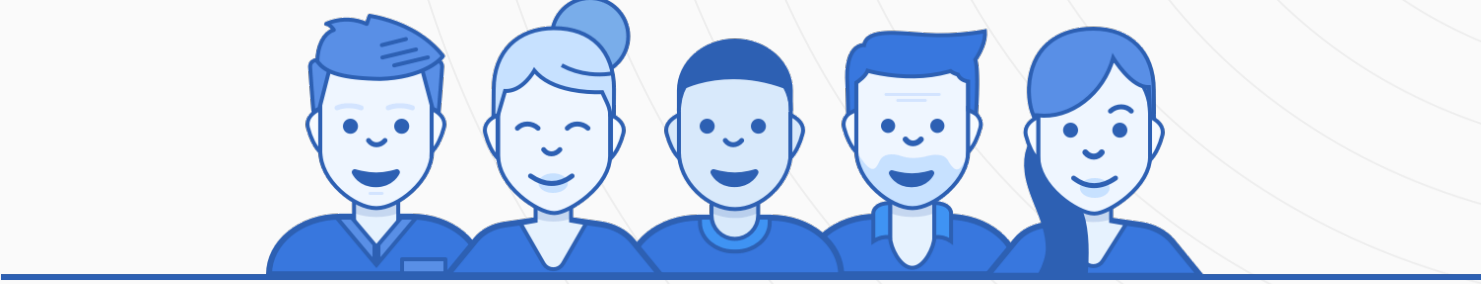

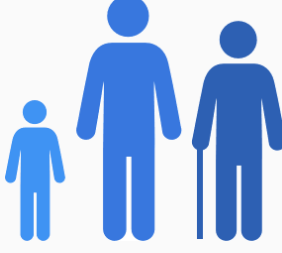


Crime rate
(per 100,000)



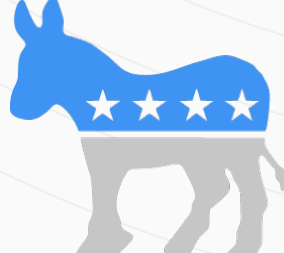

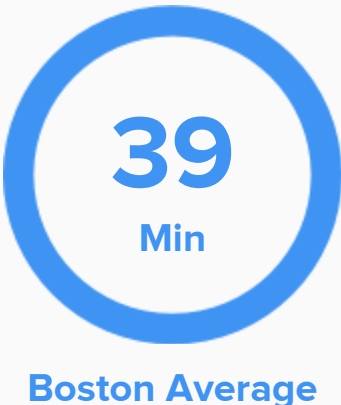

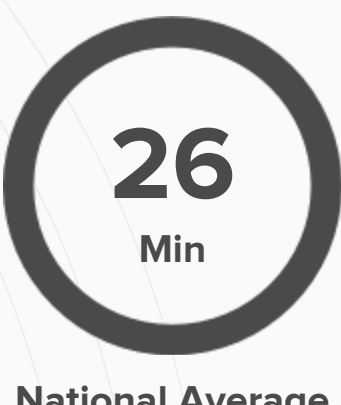
